In this article, you find some Interesting Facts about Prime Ministers of Pakistan.

The **Prime Minister of Pakistan is the head of government of Pakistan** and **designated** as the "chief executive of the Republic".

Term length in Pakistan is **5 years**.

His **Status** in Pakistan as the **Head of government**. **Residence place** of PM is **Prime Minister Enclave The seat** is **Prime Minister Secretariat**

Salary of Prime Minister of Pakistan is **16 lakh** (US\$11,000) *annually* which becomes **1.33 Lakh monthly** as per the source of Express.co.uk

NOTE: A pay of Prime mInister of Pakistan is 1 Lakhs 40 thousand per month (1,40,000/month equivalent US\$1,300) including of all allowances and exclusive of the taxes, which becomes about 16 Lakhs and 80 thousand per annum (PKR1,680,000 equivalent US\$16,000). However, it surprising that the salaries of federal ministers, state ministers, senators, high court judges, and the president are **more than the prime minister of Pakistan**.

Some other FACTS are:

- Since the Independence of Pakistan in 1947 till now 2020 a total of **30 people served** as the Prime Minister of Pakistan.
- Caretakers served as Prime Minister of Pakistan for 8 times up to now 2020.
- In <u>all 30 lists of Prime Ministers</u> and Caretakers of Pakistan up to now, 22 Prime Ministers served Pakistan as the leaders of the house.
- Since the inception of Pakistan on 14th August 1947, not a single Prime Minister of Pakistan has completed his five-year tenure.
- The first Prime Minister of Pakistan whose tenure has the 2nd longest was Liaquat Ali Khan which was 4 Years, 2 Months, 2 Days
- The **Longest Time ever Served** By a Prime Minister of Pakistan was **Yousuf Raza Geelani** who served for <u>4 Years</u>, <u>2 Months</u>, <u>25 Days</u>.
- Mohammad Nawaz Shareef became the PM of Pakistan Three Terms. His total duration was about <u>5 Years</u>, <u>2 Months</u>, <u>27 Days</u>.
- The **first woman Prime minister of Pakistan Benazir Bhutto** became the PM of Pakistan for two Terms. Her total duration was about <u>4 Years</u>, <u>8 Months</u>, <u>21 Days</u>.
- Therefore, both **Mohammad Nawaz Shareef and Benazir Bhutto** are the longest nonconsecutively serving prime ministers ever.
- The **shortest time served** by a prime minister was **Noor ul Ameen**, he served for **13 days** only during the war of 1971 Between East of Pakistan named now Bangladesh and West of Pakistan.
- The first political party **Muslim League** served **5 times as PM of Pakistan** which is the **most number of serving** prime ministers so far.
- The **longest post abolishment period** was in the times of Zia-ul-Haq which were <u>13</u> <u>years</u>, and <u>2 months</u>.
